

4th Annual Blue Mountains Tri Golf Course Stableford Tournament

Tournament Rules of Play

General

1. The Tournament is a Stableford Golf Tournament. The Tournament is played over three successive days on Leura GC, Blackheath GC and Wentworth Falls GC.



2. PGA Rules of Golf apply.

3. Handicaps applying for each Player for the three GCs' are attached. Discuss limitation of Stableford strokes on Par Threes' to one stroke

4. The winner of the Tournament will be the Player with the highest Stableford Score on for the Blackheath GC.

5. Prize Money & Trophy

The Player winning will receive the perpetual trophy to hold for one year until the following year's tournament. The winner will be responsible for arranging engraving of his win on the Trophy.

Specific

1. A Player will score for himself and one Other Player in the golf flight/group. The Golf Score Card of the golf course in play will be used.
Both the Player and the Other Player will agree their scores at the end of each hole.
Score card will:-
 - Clearly identify the player(s) name and scores
 - at the end of the round (18th hole) the card will be totalled – gross score and Stableford scores.
 - a photo of each card will be taken by the Player on his mobile phone at the end of each round.
 - the score card will be handed to MOOSE for summation onto a master score sheet.
 - MOOSE will be the sole judge of any correction because of a miscalculation made in a score card(s).
2. Golf balls must be played as they lie on the fairway and roughs (unless otherwise instructed by that Pro Shop Golf Course Notice Board)
3. The sand is not to be touched in sand bunkers before a shot is played.
4. All players in the group will tee off behind the tee box marker. The same-coloured tee marker will be used by all players.
An elected Player in a golf flight will throw balls to determine who tees off first. The ball landing closest to the thrower wins the honour to tee off, first.

5. Each Player will mark his ball.
If a Player plays the wrong ball in play that Player will earn **zero** Stapleford points for that hole.
6. If a golf ball is lost in play a replacement ball will be dropped at a point agreed by the players Other Player on his scorecard and with a one stroke penalty to the player.
