OCTOBER 2007 - ABILYMPICS MONTH

October 2007, just 4 short months away, will see the return to SA of vocational skill competitions for people with a disability during **Abilympics Month**.

A highlight of the month will be **Abilympics Landscape & Gardening** competition to be held in conjunction with the **Festival of Garden Living** to be held in Veale Gardens, Adelaide (October 19-21).
